

Tomato plants available for PPCG Gardeners for 2016 season

You may order as many as you like of as many varieties as you like by April 1st. Supply is limited and they will be distributed on a first-come – first-served basis. The plants will be available around the 15th of May, The mature days in parentheses are approximate number of days to ripening from the date of transplant.

Determinate plants are compact, non-spreading **Indeterminate** plants need trellising and they spread.

Variety	Maturity	Type	Description
Early varieties:			
Gold San Marzano	52 days	Determinate	Robust, hardy plants, very early golden Roma shaped fruit. Summer-long crop of tasty tomatoes
Silvery fir tree	58 days	Determinate	Silvery-gray lacy foliage (attractive patio plant) Hardy producer of 3 – 4” fruits ranging from deep orange to red, excellent acidic flavor.
Subarctic	57 days	Determinate	Very hardy, sets many small (1” - 2”) red fruits with tart “real tomato” flavor.
Glacier	55 days	Determinate	Very early, sweeter and more flavorful than other early varieties 2” diameter fruits grow in clusters.
Midseason varieties:			
Paul Robeson	75 days	Indeterminate	Russian heirloom. Named after Paul Robeson, operatic vocalist and activist for Black equal rights, he was appreciated worldwide and especially in Russia. Large, beautiful black tomato with red body, dark green shoulders,
Green Zebra	72 days	Indeterminate	The 3 – 4 oz tangy fruits ripen as the green fruit develops a yellow blush. Produces over the whole season.
Valencia	75 days	Indeterminate	Round 8 – 10 oz sunny orange fruits with meaty low seed interiors, great flavor.
German Red Strawberry	79 days	Indeterminate	Delicious, uniform fruit resemble large strawberries, averaging 10 oz. And 3 1/2 in long. Solid meat has few seeds and little juice, but big on taste.
Old German	75 days	Indeterminate	Heirloom originally from the Mennonite community in Virginia. Large red and yellow fruits great for slicing.
Late Season varieties			
<u>Hillbilly</u>	85 days	Indeterminate	Heirloom from West Virginia. Huge mild-flavored, beefsteak-type fruits weighing a pound or more. Unusual orange-yellow, streaked and mottled in shades of pink and red.
<u>Black Ethiopian</u>	80 days	Indeterminate	Unique dark mahogany heirloom from Hungary. Plum shape, rich tangy flavor, 3 to 5 oz.
<u>Fried Green Hybrid</u>	80 days	Indeterminate	Specially selected to remain firm when cooked. Can be harvested when apple green or yellow.
<u>Black Pineapple</u>	85 days	Indeterminate	Ranges from black-purple to hazy green with red-pink or yellow patches. They have bright green flesh with red-pink striations, and have a sweet, fruity, smoky flavor.
<u>Brandywine Sudduth</u>	90 days	Indeterminate	Large pink beefsteak - up to 2 lbs. Incredibly rich, delightfully intense tomato flavor.
<u>Costoluto Genovese</u>	85 days	Indeterminate	Italian heirloom highly lobed, carmine-red fruits. Look like flowers when sliced – delicious taste
<u>Striped German</u>	80 days	Indeterminate	Bicolor red and yellow 10- 12 oz fruit. The marbled interior looks beautiful sliced, and has a fruity flavor.
<u>Big Zac</u>	80 days	Indeterminate	Very large 4 – 6 lb red fruit – meaty and delicious. Hybrid of heirloom beefsteak and brandy varieties.
Cherry tomatoes			
<u>Sun Gold</u>	57 days	Indeterminate	Heavy and early producer of so very sweet gold to orange fruits all season long.
<u>Sweet Million</u>	60 days	Indeterminate	High producer of tasty, red, sweet tomatoes 1 – 1 1/2” in diameter. Starts early and produces until frost.
<u>Sungreen Cherry</u>	70 days	Indeterminate	Lime-green Japanese hybrid. Candy sweet.
<u>Black grape</u>	64 days	Indeterminate	Medium size cherry, ripens to a bronze-black fruit, very tasty. All season producer.
